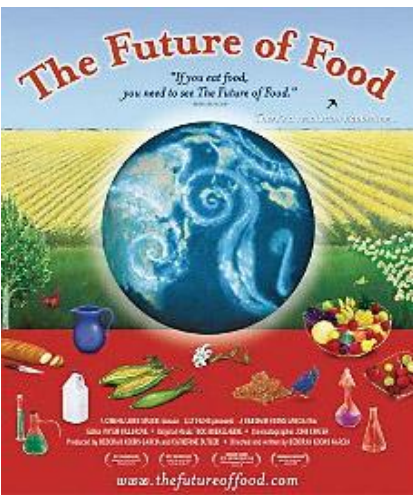

Our food system is undergoing unprecedented change. Unbeknownst to most of us, we are consuming genetically engineered food without our knowledge or our permission. This technology is difficult to grasp, and the regulatory, agricultural, consumer, health, and moral issues all need scrutiny. Many large agro corporations use this technology to position themselves as the answer to the world food crisis while consolidating, and patenting the seed supply. The ugly truth is that GE crops have failed to deliver on their empty promises of increased yields, while increasing harm upon both ecosystem & human health.

This film distills the complex technology surrounding genetically engineered foods, the implications of seed patents, and the corporatization of food into terms the average person can easily understand. It empowers consumers to realize the consequences of their food choices on our future, and catalyzes a mandatory GMO-labelling movement.
